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Providing feedback to your doctor

Patient Information

You may be asked to provide feedback on your doctor following an appointment with them.

It is not mandatory but we would encourage you to take part.

Is the process anonymous?

Yes, please ensure you do not enter any personal information when completing the feedback. The responses are collated into a report by Orbit360 for the doctor to reflect upon.

How do I provide feedback?

You have been asked to provide feedback and have an opportunity to read some guidance on completing the survey.

You can then provide feedback in two ways;

- 1. Complete a **paper feedback** survey and follow the instructions set by the person facilitating the process
- 2. Provide feedback **online** using the unique code at the top of the form.

Orbit360 compiles patient feedback into a report that the doctor will use to meet the requirements of revalidation.

BE HONEST - your feedback is useful if it is honest. Tell your doctor what they do well and what you would like them to do differently.
